Hamtramck Barely Beats Southeastern

A slam in the pole vault and a tie for first and second in the high jump provided the margin of victory for Hamtramck over Southeastern in a dual track meet Friday. Hamtramck won, 50 to 45. Southeastern proved strong in the running events with firsts in the 220-yard dash, the half-mile, relay and the one-mile run, besides winning the shot put. In the latter Harold Cochrell set a new Southeastern gymnasium record with a toss of 45 feet, 2 inches, while Dick Bell ran the 880 in 2:10 for another Southeastern record.
