

Track Meet Won by Cass

Tech Outscores Western, Southwestern

Cass Tech gained its first track victory of the season Tuesday in defeating Western and Southwestern in a triangular meet. Cass scored 53½ points to 47½ for Western and 17 for Southwestern. The meet was staged in the Cass gymnasium.

The Cass athletes won six of the 11 firsts and tied with Western for another. Western took three events and Southwestern the other.

There were no double winners. Frank Gergel, of Western, placed second in the 25-yard dash and in both the high and low hurdles. William Lawrence, co-captain of the Cass squad, took the 25-yard dash and was second to Eldrich Glover, a teammate, in the 220.

Alex Milne took the running high jump to give Southwestern its only first.
