Colts Register in Five Events

Huskies Behind Only by Two Points

Northwestern, 11 times winner of the City High School indoor track championship, had a two-point lead on Redford, its closest competitor, with seven events finished Wednesday afternoon in the annual West Side meet at Northwestern.

Captain Sam Hooton's Colts won points in five of the seven events for a 22 1/2-point total. Redford, with most of its strength in the long run, was second with 20 1/2 points. Cooley ranked third with 17 1/2 points. Other schools to score were Central, 8 1/2 points; Western, five; Cass Tech, one and a fifth; and Chalmers and Southwestern, one each.

Four events to be completed Thursday, the thirty-yard low and high hurdles, the thirty-yard dash and the 80-yard relay will determine the championship. Any one of the three leaders may win the championship.

Bad Break Cooley

Northwestern won only two first places Wednesday, but it was only one of the "rough breaks" of indoor track which stopped the Colts from gaining a bigger margin. Ulysses Amos, the Colts' sixteen-year-old Negro sprint star, turned in the outstanding performance of the day, but it was Amos who also lost valuable points for Northwestern.

Amos led the quarter-mile in 53.45 seconds. This is only one-fifth of a second slower than the record set by Lewis Dyrus, of Northwestern, in 1935. It was the thirty-yard dash, where Amos was a favorite that the Colts had their sure points. The 200-yard dash, was run in heats with two runners in each heat.

Amos ran against Douglas Pearce, of Redford, but the Colt star became confused in his legs and stopped cutting a half a lap before the finish. Pearce was clocked in 25.45 seconds and Amos had a small lead on the Redford runner before he stopped. However, another Northwestern sprinter, Eddie Lampan, who is not rated on fast as Amos, placed first in 25.25 seconds. Amos is out of the City semi-finals as a result of his error.

Records Made

No records were equalled or broken Wednesday but a pair of high hurdles Bob Luby of Central, and Bob Sullivan, of Cooley, came within a fifth of a second of the thirty-year high hurdle record by winning final heats in 4:25 seconds.
