

## CENTRAL SECOND IN SAGINAW MEET

**Tycocki and Roberts Lead  
Big Reds; Saginaw High  
Wins; Eastern Fourth**

**OLD RECORD SHATTERED**

SAGINAW, April 27 — Garnering five first places and providing the only record-smashing performance made during the day, Lansing Central high school's track team placed second in a quadrangular meet held here Saturday.

Saginaw high school with a total of 56 1/2 points, was winner of the meet while the Big Reds trailed with 31, Saginaw Arthur Hill 26 1/2, and Lansing Eastern 17 1/2.

Ralph Roberts, metro sprinter, and Theodore Tycocki, broad jumper and hurdler, were the big guns in the Big Red lineup, accounting for 20 1/2 points between them. Tycocki broke a school record of 40 years standing when he leaped 22 feet 9 inches in the broad jump to better the old mark of 21 feet 10 1/2 inches set by Clarence Christopher in 1896. He also eclipsed the Alumni field record here by 10 1/2 inches.

Roberts spreadeagled the field in the 100 and 220-yard dashes. He was clocked in 10 1/4 for the 100 and 22 1/4 for the 220. In the closest race of the day Ed Dudley of Central shaded Hill Sikes of Eastern, in the 880-yard run, breasting the tape a scant half yard ahead of the Quaker runner.

The Central 880-yard relay team of Pousum, Baker, Tycocki, and Roberts ran a fine race to win the event in the time of 13:04. Saunders and Wouch gave Eastern its only first, tying with Eagle of Saginaw in the pole vault at 10 feet 6 inches.
