

Marks Topple in State Meet

Monroe High Heads 4 New Champs

GRAND RAPIDS, May 23.—(A.P.)—Four new records were set into the track meet records here today and permitted the coach to weigh for another year.

Monroe High School took over the Class A crown that Saginaw Huntington won 20 years ago. It alone was able to beat three challengers, while Owasco by the narrowest of margins repeated its title as the holder of Class D honors. Lakeview of Class D Shores, was only three points behind in the scoring, with 18 points.

The records took a severe jolting, in addition to the records that were thought officially, but other of the old marks were believed to be unrecorded because the contestants ran with a strong wind at their backs.

Tyrock of Lansing Central, took over the Class A 200-yard sprint record with a 24.60, 11.4 inches less that before by a fraction of the track that had been set by Hildebrand, of Okemos, Huron in 1916, a 18.44 mile in Class B that was three tenths of a second better than the three-year-old record, while Elroy of Plymouth took a hard fall over the Class C short-run mark, bettering the old record of 41 feet, 11.2 inches by 1.25 inches and carries intensity by Class D topping the bar at 11 feet 2 inches a half-inch better than the old one.

Elroy, of Napoleon, did the Class D low hurdles in 21.2 seconds in quality 4 tenths of a second faster than the record, but was not credited with it because of the wind. The same was true in the performance of Joseph, of St. Joseph, in the Class B high hurdles, with the 114 performance better than the recognized 116 of Clarence of Saginaw in the Class A.

A record of this event, with 11.3, was set by the recognized 11.6 of Mack of Owasco, in the 113 division, whose 114 beat the record 114.1 and Owasco's 116 was the old record.

Mason of Monroe, qualifying to run the Class A 200, was appointed recognition as a record breaker although the elapsed time was two tenths of a second below the official mark.

But the 80 boys completed in the fall, year, which was brought back for the first time last year because it normal home—Michigan State College—was without a track temporarily.
