## Trojans Defeat Northern Twice

### Viking Hurlers Are Hit Hard by Saginaw

Saginaw—Unable to throttle the hard-hitting Saginaw High school baseball team, Coach Jimmy Barclay's Flint Northern nine went down to defeat in both ends of a double header Saturday at Alumni field.

The Eskimos lost the morning contest, 12-2, and finished on the short end of a 10 to 4 count in the afternoon game. Saginaw's double victory gave it a tie for second place in the Saginaw Valley league standings with Arthur Hill.

Saginaw mauled Henry Fry and Bob Marzonie, Northern hurlers, for 13 hits in the first game to win about as they pleased. In the second contest the Trojans found Herman Dreyer for 10 hits in four innings, but could do nothing against Don Fleischmann in the last two frames. Fleischmann was pitching for the first time in competition.

Tony Szymborski, who went the route on the mound for Saginaw in the first game, set the Eskimos down with only five hits. Bryant and Skrocki, who divided the Trojan pitching duties in the second game, allowed only seven hits. Tony Ananich and DeMartin each made two in four trips to bat in the second contest.

After tying the score in the third inning of the first game, Saginaw scored three runs in the fourth frame to take the lead and then went on to win about as it pleased. The Trojans jumped away to an early lead in the second game and finished it with several reserves in its lineup.
