

BRISK BREEZE AIDS ATTACK ON RECORDS

**Many City and State
Marks Equaled or
Beaten, but the New
Times Are Not Cer-
tified.**

Grand Rapids South High school was leading the state class A track competition at Houseman field at the close of the morning activities Saturday with 13 points in 2 events completed.

The next closest rivals were Grand Rapids Central and Royal Oak, with 6 each.

Although numerous state and city high school marks were shattered and equaled, tournament officials disallowed them because of the brisk breeze that aided the contestants.

Plymouth Leads Class B.

Plymouth was out ahead in class B competition with 11 points. East Grand Rapids and Lowell were tied for the class C lead with 6 points each and Lakeview of St. Clair Shores paced Class D with 19 points.

South's entrants came through strongly in the high jump, totalling 9 points when McDonald and Seif tied for second place. The two favorites in the event ran into an upset when Keegstra of Grand Rapids Central did 5 feet 11 3/4 inches to win first place. South's other points came in the shotput when Bob Savage took third place.

Davis Tech was the third Grand Rapids school to figure in the morning summary. Its big Negro shotputter, Wright, took fourth place in that event.

Local Dashers Do Well.

The Grand Rapids sprint and hurdle entries did fairly well. McDonald of South recording the best high-hurdle qualifying time. Dykehouse of Davis Tech led his heat in the 100-yard dash and qualified easily in the 220 also.

Catholic Central qualified Bartnick in the 220-yard dash. Amon of Union barely made the finals in the 100-yard dash after a runoff with two others for seventh position.

Dykehouse turned in mark of 10 flat in the qualifying 100-yard dash, beating the city record of 10.1. The state mark is 9.8.

Conlee, the Allegan flash, equaled the 100-yard dash mark of 10.2 in class B qualifying trials and Cherry of Lakeview high. St. Clair Shores, in class D, did the century in 10.3, beating the state mark of 10.4.

Hurdle Marks Toppled.

Hurdle records also went by the boards. McDonald of South, in the class A 120-yard high hurdles, turned in a mark of 15.4, three-tenths of a second faster than the city record and clipping two-tenths off the state record.

Oswalt of Paw Paw, in class C, turned in a mark of 16.1 in the 120-yard high event, beating the old mark of 16.2.

In the 200-yard class A low hurdles Mason of Monroe clipped two-tenths of a second off the old record of 23.2. In the class D event Smoyer of Napoleon turned in a mark of 25.2, shattering the state record of 25.8.

Spartans Win Over Ohio State Nine

East Lansing, May 23.—(A)—Michigan State turned in a 6-5 victory over Ohio State in the first of a two-game series here Saturday. Ohio State out-hit the Spartans 13 to 8 but left 11 men stranded on the bases.

Ohio State scored a run in the first inning and State matched it in the second. A three-run splurge in the fifth inning, featured by a tremendous home run clout delivered by Steve Sebo with a maul on sent the Spartans out in front and they were never headed.
