

Records Toppled In Sanilac Meet

Six Broken as Sandusky Wins Championship

Sandusky — Six Sanilac track records were smashed here Friday in the county track meet of the Sanilac High School Athletic association, held at the Fairgrounds.

Sandusky won the boys' county track title with 41½ points. Deckerville was second with 32, Marlette third with 24 and Croswell fourth with 18½.

In the girls' division, Sandusky and Deckerville tied for the county title with 17 points each.

Bob Hastings of Sandusky, who was high point man of the meet with 16½ points, set new records in the 100 and 220-yard dash events and was a member of the boys' lay team which set a new county record. The time on the 100 was 10.2. The time on the 220 was 23.2 and the time on the relay was 1.40.

The Sandusky girls' relay team set a new county record of 26.1 seconds. In the 50-yard dash Helen Patten of Sandusky set a new county record of 6.4. Elsie Blashill of Sandusky threw the baseball 194 feet 7 inches to break the county record in that event.
