

Track Honors To Caro High

Tuscola Association Title Taken as Mayville Wins in Baseball

Caro—Although her athletes placed first in only three of the 12 events, Caro High school cashed in on a bevy of minor places to win team honors in the 30th annual Field day of the Tuscola County High School Athletic association, held at Caro Fair Grounds Friday. Results showed Caro ahead with 74 5-8 points, followed by Vassar 44, Fairgrove 30 5-6, Cass City 22 1-3, Mayville 2 and Millington 1.

Caesar Harper, Vassar's "Midnight Express," was the high point man of the meet with 15 winning first in all three events in which he was entered, the 100 and 220-yard dashes and the broad jump. He also ran first in the relay, and led the field at the end of the first lap. Robinson, Fairgrove, broke the only record when he was clocked at 16.3 seconds in the 120-yard high hurdles. He beat R. Smith, Caro, who set the record last year. Smith finished third, behind Satchell of Caro, second.

Robinson, Caro, holder of the 880-yard record, easily out distanced the field in that event, but was disqualified for cutting in to the pole too soon, Lewis of Vassar, who ran second, being awarded first place.

Mayville defeated Millington, 10 to 4, for the county baseball championship.
