

Track Laurels To Mt. Morris

All Three Genesee County Championships Go to That City

Fenton— Pre-tournament dopsters were 100 per cent right when they picked Mt. Morris schools to sweep the annual Genesee County Track and Field meet, which was staged here Saturday.

Mt. Morris High school easily outdistanced Clio for honors in Class C. Mt. Morris St. Mary rang up more than twice the number of points it needed to win the Class D championship from Goodrich and Mt. Morris High girls captured their division handily.

Although it took only one more first place than Clio, Mt. Morris' supporting strength brought a 14 1-3 point advantage. Mt. Morris, led by Lewis Kotwicki, who paced his team to the Saginaw Valley Class B regional title earlier in the season, ran up 53 1-3 points. Clio had 41.

Kotwicki captured half of his team's six first places Saturday, winning the 120-yard low hurdles, 100-yard dash and shotput. Clio's five firsts were split among its contestants and not one of the four other schools participating in this class won an event.

Flushing came through for third place, earning 20 points. Fenton salvaged only 4 points, Davison 2 and Grand Blanc did not score.

St. Mary's powerful squad had no trouble piling up the 66½ points by which it won the Class C crown. Eight first places plus strong placing performances gave the Marys easy claim to the title. Goodrich, finishing second in this division, took the other three firsts while it was gathering 30 points. Hoover of Flint finished a good third with a point total of 23½ markers.

Farney of St. Mary and Lesko of Goodrich were among the high point individuals in this meet, each capturing two first places. Lesko took the broad jump and 880-yard run while Farney captured high jump and shot put honors.

Mt. Morris High easily outdistanced the four other schools which competed in the one class girls division of the tournament. Winning four of the six first places, Mt. Morris finished with a 29½ point total, Grand Blanc trailed with 13 while Goodrich had 8½, Davison 7½ and Fenton 6½.
