

# Dominates West Meet

## Colt Athletes Take 4 of First 5 Events

Northwestern High has not won a City outdoor track championship since 1931 when it captured its eighth team title in nine years. Since then, it has been Eastern and Hamtramck that have divided the honors, the former taking two championships and the latter three.

Northwestern may not win the City title next month, but it must be considered a serious contender, if the results of events in the West League meet at U. of D. Stadium Thursday mean anything.

### WIN 4 OF 5 EVENTS

Five finals were held, Northwestern winning four, the one-mile run, pole vault, shot putt and discuss throw, while the other, the high jump, went to Alex Milne of Southwestern. "We'd have won that, too, if Ray Rostel, our best high jumper, hadn't left school," remarked Sam Bishop, the Northwestern coach.

In the five completed events Northwestern scored 30 points to 19 for Southwestern, four for Mackenzie and two for Cass.

Northwestern also qualified heavily in the remaining events, finals of which will be held next week. It placed three runners in the low hurdles, 100 and 220-yard dashes and the half-mile run, and two each in the high hurdles and the 440-yard run.

### MEETS END NEXT WEEK

The west league meet will be concluded on Wednesday, May 26, but it is almost a certainty that Northwestern will be the winner. The east league meet will be held on Monday and Thursday and the north league on Tuesday and Friday. The place winners in the three leagues qualify for the Metropolitan championships on June 2 and 4.
