

Hastings Takes Prep Loop Net, Track Crowns

Hastings—Hastings won a double victory at the West Central league field day at Ionia Saturday by taking the track and field meet and the tennis tournament. Hastings scored 55½ points, Belding 37, Ionia 30½, and Greenville 9 in a track meet in which the winners' superiority in the distance runs was too great for their league rivals. Using the new regional plan of scoring, Hastings took six points in the tennis tournament, Ionia two, and Belding two.

Four new records were set in the track and field events. Smith of Hastings lowered his previous mark in the half mile to 2:15.2. Miller of Belding broadjumped 21 feet 10 inches. Bessmer of Hastings put the shot 40 feet 6¾ inches, and Price of Belding vaulted 10 feet 3 inches. Smith was high point man, taking 13 points with firsts in the half mile and high jump, and a second in the broad jump.

Hastings won both the singles and doubles tennis finals. Angell retained the singles crown, which he won last year, by a 9-7, 6-3 victory over Spencer of Belding. Caukin and Shawman defeated Wilder and Wetzel of Ionia 6-2, 6-1 in the doubles finals.
