Cosmos Lead in Relay Meet

Hamtramck Runners Win Three Races

Hamtramck and Cooley in Class A with Birmingham in Class B stood out in Wayne University's fourth annual relay carnival at Belle Isle Saturday.

Hamtramck's Cosmos turned in the fastest times in three of the six A relays. Cooley had the fastest time in two, while Northwestern won the other. Cooley also captured one of the five field events.

Birmingham captured both of the B relays, the half-mile and medley besides taking first in the pole vault. In the medley Birmingham's time was 2.9 seconds faster than Northwestern, Class A winner.

ABBOTT WINS

Six of the fastest sprinters in the Metropolitan area competed in an invitational 100-yard dash, the event going to Bob Abbott, Redford's City champion, in 10.2 seconds. Peter Stancil of Hamtramck was second and Clark Collins of Birmingham third.

Hamtramck ran off with the shuttle, one-mile and two-mile relays, while Cooley placed first in the quarter and half-mile events.

RECORD BROKEN

One meet record was broken and another tied in the meet. Carl Garack of Wyandotte surpassed by half an inch the mark he set last year in the Class A shot put with a toss of 49 feet 5 1/4 inches. Hamtramck's two-mile relay quartet equaled the meet mark of 8:30.6.

Twenty five schools and more than 350 athletes competed in the events.
