

MONROE SQUAD OUSTED AFTER FOUR YEARS

MONROE, May 21. — Fordson High's track team won the fifth annual Border Cities League and regional meet here Saturday afternoon, amassing a total of 52½ points. Monroe, 1937 state track champ and winner of the league title for the last four years, was second with 38 points. Other team scores were Grosse Pointe and Wyandotte tied for third with 29 each, Mt. Clemens 19½ and Royal Oak 18.

Fordson took six of a possible 14 first places, with Eddie Dragg leading the scorers with 11¼ points. Dragg won the 220-yard dash and the broad jump and ran the anchor leg on the winning relay team.

Bob Smith, Grosse Pointe senior, broke the league 120-yard high hurdles mark with a time of 15.3 seconds and tied the league record in the 220-yard low hurdles in 22.3 seconds in a preliminary heat. Bill Campbell of Monroe set the old records in 1937.

Fred Nassar of Fordson set a new record in the 440-yard dash in 52.1 seconds, breaking the old mark by one-tenth of a second. Stan Richardson of Monroe set a new half-mile run in 2 minutes 5.1 seconds.
