

East Lansing's Trojans Win Albion Track Title

(Special to The State Journal) ALBION, May 13—East Lansing's well balanced track team easily won the Class B division of the Albion college second annual high school invitational track meet here Saturday. The Trojans won seven firsts and a number of other places to amass 47 1/2 points while trailing in second place was Albion with 19 1/2. Flint Central was the Class A winner and Paw Paw topped the Class C-D division.

In the C-D field Fowlerville placed fourth with 13 points and the State School for the Blind was tenth with two points. Daley won the 440-yard dash. Sober paced the 880-yard run field and Eaton was third in the high hurdles for Fowlerville's points. Moorehead scored a point for the blind school with a fourth in the low hurdles and the school's relay team was fourth for another point.
