

Three Lenawee Athletes Score In State Meet at East Lansing

EAST LANSING, May 29—Three Lenawee county trackmen scored points here Saturday in the 33rd annual Michigan High School Athletic Association track and field meet.

Morenci high school, competing in Class C, tied for 17th place in a field of 71 schools as Walter Leech and Stan Porter scored in the half mile and 440 yard dash, respectively. Leech placed second in his heat

in the half mile with a time of 2:08.5 and Porter also placed second in the 400 yard dash with a time of 53.6 seconds. Both athletes scored in the Lenawee county meet and the Adrian College invitational.

Wallace Boyd of Clayton picked up a pair of second places for his school in the Class D division of the meet. He placed second in the high jump and also in the 220 yard dash. Boyd was a triple winner in the all-county meet at Adrian a few weeks ago.
