

Trackers Conquer Vikings
Central High Team Keeps Record Spotless, Wins 551.3 to 482.3

(Special to The State Journal) JACKSON, May 6.—Lansing Central track forces grabbed their third dual meet victory of the season last Friday afternoon by outscoring Jackson high school, 551.3 to 482.3 in a five-a-mat program.

The Big Red, surprise team of the season, gained only an even trace of off the first place against the Vikings, who had won the last dual account for their triumph.

George Nicholas won another first place in the 120 high hurdles, clocking over the barrier in 1:48. Hugh Davis was first in the 100 and 220-yard dashes again, the only Big Red to capture two events.
