

BEARCAT TRACKERS CONQUER QUAKERS

Battle Creek Downs Eastern
Despite Stellar Showing
Of Dale Kaulitz

BATTLE CREEK, May 6 — Battle Creek high school drew up to a .500 rating in the Five A league track standings for the season this morning by administering a 62 to 42 defeat to Lansing Eastern in a dual meet at Central Athletic field.

The Bearcats took eight of the 12 first places and tied for another, just reversing the order of things a week ago when Battle Creek lost to Lansing Central in the capital city, 58 to 46.

The Quakers kept close during the early stages of the meet today mainly because of the fine work of Dale Kaulitz, Eastern's all-around athlete who won three first places in the 120 yard high hurdles, 200 yard low hurdles and broad jump for high point laurels. One of the best performances of the day was exhibited by Don Henry of Battle Creek in winning the half mile in 2:10.4.

Easterns other first went to Bozack in the pole vault who tied McIntyre of the Bearcats at 9 feet, 6 inches.
