

B. H. TRACKMEN FAIL TO PLACE

Competing under adverse weather conditions and on a track muddied by frequent downpours which several times halted the meet, Bert Copeland and Frank Pate failed to place in the Michigan A. A. U. Track and Field meet Saturday at Ypsilanti.

Copeland barely failed to qualify in the 100-yard dash in a blanket finish with the fastest collegiate sprinters in the state. Alan Smith of the University of Michigan, Gerald Stukkie (Michigan collegiate champ of Western State college) and Doran of Michigan State nosed him out. Smith was the eventual winner in 10 seconds flat.

Copeland also missed a place in the broad jump after fouling on leaps over 22 feet. William Watson of the University of Michigan won this event as well as the shot put and discus throw.

Pate was far out of the money in the mile run which was won in 4:29 on the sloppy track.

Michigan State, with the largest number of entries, won the meet with 44 points, the Detroit Police were second with 34 and University of
