

# Track Honors to Wyandotte

## Wins Relay to Top Field in Rouge's Meet

ANN ARBOR, Mich., March 30.—(AP)—A team of six stalwarts from Wyandotte High defeated 16 rival squads today at Yost Field House in the second annual River Rouge invitational interscholastic track meet.

Winning the relay, final event on the program, Wyandotte nosed out Monroe, 28 to 27 1-10, with River Rouge, last year's champion, in third place with 21 1/2 points.

Three meet records were broken and two were equaled, largest of its kind outside Detroit. Bill Bowden of Lansing Eastern clipped 1.3 seconds from the record while winning the 440-yard dash in 54.4 seconds.

Bill Bailey, of Adrian, won the 60-yard dash in :06.6, a tenth of a second under the previous mark, and Tom Kneebone of Saginaw Eastern took 1.3 seconds off the record in the half mile with a 2:11.1 performance.
