

## Cooley Takes Big Lead in Track Meet

*Wins Three Firsts;  
Six Events Delayed  
Because of Rain*

Despite rain which caused postponement of the six final running events, probably until after the City finals, Cooley High School took a commanding lead Friday in the West Side track meet at the U. of D.

The Cardinals captured firsts in three of the four final events run off before the coaches held a conference on the wet field and decided to hold the 100, 220, 440, the high and low hurdles and the relay later.

Added to their firsts in the pole vault and high jump Tuesday, the victories Friday gave the Cardinals five in 12 events.

Qualifiers in the six semifinal running events will be picked to compete in the City semifinal.

**Score Heavily in Mile**

Cooley's biggest victory of the afternoon came in the mile run, in which Britton Lux, Hank Lord and Joe Ziembrocki finished one-two-three. Lux's time was 4:42, which is comparatively slow for the Cardinals, but the milers were running on a water-soaked track.

Tom Colnason won the 880-yard run for Cooley in 2:02. He was followed across the finish line by Robert Thomas, of Northwestern, and Central's Milt Rubin, who came in third.

The third Cardinal victory came in the broad jump, which Bert Yoight took with a leap of 18 feet 11 inches. Another Central athlete, Julian Stern, placed second, and Bob Bliss, of Redford, third.

**Western Star Wins Shot**

The only event which Cooley lost was the shot put, which went to Vic Bridges, of Western, with a toss of 47 feet 6 1/2 inches.

Cardinal track teams coached by Claud Slatery have won their last five East and West Side dual meets in a row, and are defending City outdoor champions.
