By taking third place in the Five-A meet, at Albion, the Vikings qualified for a place in the State meet to be held at East Lansing Saturday, May 25. Jay Woolsey was the only player, for Jackson, to take a first place in the meet.

The much postponed meet with Kalamazoo was finally held, but the Vikings were defeated by the Celery City team. Kalamazoo copped six first places, while Jackson took only five. By scoring heavily in seconds and thirds, Central won the meet.

DeMay finished in a twelve way tie for second place in the high jump.
