

Records Take Bad Beating in State Meet

Field House Marks Set by Thomas, Tolmich, Williams

ANN ARBOR, March 19.—An assault on records tonight in the annual Michigan A.A.U. relays lowered three Yost Field House marks.

The Michigan relay team, composed of Al Thomas, Bob Barnard, Warren Brudenbach and Bob Ufer, took one-tenth of a second off the mile record, beating Notre Dame, Central Intercollegiate champion, in 3 minutes, 19.7 seconds.

\$3,000 Wanders Detroit Streets

University, bettered the Field House shot put mark by nearly a foot, heaving the shot 52 feet 4½ inches on his first attempt. The previous record was 51 feet 5½ inches.

Al Thomas, of Michigan, lowered the record in the 65-yard hurdles, finishing in 7.4 seconds. The old record was 7.5 seconds.

Tolmich, National A.A.U. high-hurdle champion, won the 65-yard high hurdles in 8 seconds, to tie the Field House record.

Indiana's great distance runner, Campbell Kane, led the way to the tape in a special invitational mile run, finishing in 4 minutes 13.8 seconds.

Other A.A.U. meet records were established, starting with the first event, the mile walk, in which William Minolo, of Hamtramck City Boys Club, led the pacers to the tape in 7 minutes 2.6 seconds. The old mark was 7 minutes 13 seconds.
