

E. Jackson Wins Title

Takes Regional Track Meet at Kalamazoo.

Kalamazoo-(Special)-East Jackson High school won the regional track championship Saturday with 56 1-2 points and qualified seven boys for the state meet in two weeks. Paw Paw was second with 33 1-2 and Plainwell third with 29 1-2.

Dick Hume was a double winner for the Trojans, taking the 120-yard high hurdles in 16.5 and the 200-yard low hurdles in 24.8, and Chet Potrawa also helped the cause with two firsts, copping his section of the 440-yard dash in 54.3 and heaving the shot 42 feet for his other first. Leroy Pahl won the broad jump with a leap of 19 feet 6 1-2 inches and the half-mile relay team of Bob Smith, Pahl, Bob Phelps and Potrawa was victorious in 1:37.7.

Bob Smith was third in the high hurdles and Pahl and Bob Phelps second and third respectively in the 100-yard dash. Elmer Burke copped fourth place in the mile, with Bob Smith second and Pahl fifth in the low hurdles. Andy Sotak finished second and Carl Conrad fourth in the half-mile run, Miller tied for fifth in the pole vault and Nile Rider, a freshman, was third in the broad jump.
