

Michigan high-school track athletes engaged in regional meets at various centers throughout the state Saturday.

The outstanding performance of the day was turned in by Forrest Naveaux, of Monroe, who cleared 12 feet 5 inches in the pole vault in Class A competition at Ypsilanti. Two years ago in the State meet at East Lansing, Forrest's brother Jim established the present Michigan record of 12 feet 4 and  $\frac{1}{8}$  inches.

The Ypsilanti regional record for the Class B shot put was broken by Howard Oehmke, of East Detroit, who tossed the twelve-pound iron ball 48 feet 10  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches.

At Mt. Pleasant new champions were crowned, with Alma winning in Class B, Imlay City Class C and Blanchard Class D.
