

## Southeastern Easily Takes Track Title

Southeastern High School's track team completed its sweep of city track honors this year by running away with the City League outdoor track meet Thursday at U. of D. Stadium.

The victory gave Coach Leighton Boyd's Jungaleers the top three track titles of the year—Wayne Relays, City League indoor and City League outdoor.

No other team in recent years has given quite as impressive a performance in winning as did the Jungaleers. They placed in 10 of the 12 events and took four first places for 892.5 points, more than double its nearest challenger's total. Mackenzie won the battle for second place with 42 points to 35 for Hamtramck and 34 for Northwestern, the West Side champion.

Other team scores were: Central, 291.5; Northeastern, 21; Eastern, 20; Cooley, 191.5; Cass Tech, 161.5; Pershing, 15; Western, 11; Redford and Miller, 10 each; Denby, 7; Southwestern, 6, and Northern, 4.

Despite the perfect track weather, no records were broken. The best showing was by Elmer Swanson, husky Northeastern senior, who scored a double in the
