

The commendable distance of 35 feet 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches was racked up by Beverly Upper of Grand Blanc in the girls class B shot put event to wipe out Dobbs' distance of 32 feet 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches set in 1940 for Fenton. The other new mark set in this division was the standing broad jump which was taken by Bettie French of Mt. Morris, who jumped 7 feet 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches. This was $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch better than the record established by Pierce of Beecher last year.

A new shot put record of 29 feet 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches was turned in by Betty Murphy of Mt. Morris St. Mary in the girls Class C division. The old mark of 28 feet 4 $\frac{1}{8}$ inches was held by Murphy of the same school in 1939. The girls Class C hop-step-jump mark was shoved up to 28 feet 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches by Jean Orr of Goodrich. This bettered by 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches the old record set by Dobis of Mt. Morris St. Mary last year.

Mt. Morris was forced into the runnerup slot in the Class B group with 44.6 points while Grand Blanc was close behind in third with 30.2. The remaining finishing order was Flushing, 18.3, Davison, 15.3, and Clio, 15.1.
