

## Ann Arbor Trackmen Win River Rouge Meet

ANN ARBOR— (AP) —Ann Arbor high school nosed out Flint Northern, 27½ to 22 2-3, here Saturday to capture the fourth annual River Rouge Invitational indoor track meet after Flint was disqualified in the medley relay for passing an opponent on the inside.

River Rouge was third with 22 points, Jackson and Royal Oak, tied for fourth with 19½; Pontiac, 16¾; Monroe, 15; Battle Creek, 12; and Birmingham, 11½.

Horace Smith, sensational Jackson Negro sprinter, took individual honors with two firsts and one fourth, speeding the 65 yard high hurdles in 8.2 seconds, four-tenths of a second better than the existing record.

Corunna, a class C school, contributed a record-breaker in Stan Bocek who heaved the 12 pound shot 48 feet, 10¾ inches.

Record-smashing was the rule of the day rather than the exception, the more than 300 athletes from 32 high schools freely clipping existing standards.
