

Kazoo Central Wins State Prep Track Crown

EAST LANSING, May 23.—

Kalamazoo Central captured Class A honors in the twentieth annual Michigan high school track and field meet here today by rolling up 32 points.

Grand Rapids Union and Flint Central were second with 22, while Flint Northern was fourth with 21 $\frac{3}{8}$.

In Class B, Birmingham took first place with 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ points, while Three Rivers was runnerup with 24 1-7. Class laurels went to Imlay City 40 $\frac{2}{3}$, Granville, 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ points. Bear Lake ran away with Class D honors for the second straight year.

Kalamazoo Central produced five event winners in a meet that saw four records fall.

Jack Steelman placed Birmingham in Class B by winning the 100 and 220-yard dashes.

Forest Naveaux, the last of the pole-vaulting Naveaux brothers from Monroe, leaped 12 feet 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches to break the mark of 12 feet 4 $\frac{5}{8}$ inches set by his brother, James, in 1939. Another pole vault mark was set in Class C when Jay Decou of Marine City went 11 feet 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches, $\frac{3}{4}$ inch over the old mark.

Bill Dale of Wayne broke the Class B high jump mark with a leap of 6 feet 2 inches.
