

Close County Track Race Seen

Fenton and Mt. Morris Class B Favorites

Fenton and Mt. Morris are expected to wage a close duel for Class B honors in the Genesee county track and field meet Friday at Dort field. The competition, which includes girls' as well as boys' events in classes B and C, will start at 12 o'clock noon.

Fenton scored over its two hottest rivals, Mt. Morris and Grand Blanc, in a meet at Grand Blanc Wednesday, tallying .55 points. Mt. Morris got 40 2/3 points and Grand Blanc, 34 1/3.

George Dunn, Grand Blanc star, who had amassed about 130 points, pulled a leg muscle earlier in the week, and was on the sidelines.

Bill Holloway, Mt. Morris' state champion miler, was shifted to sprints, and placed second to his teammate, Ron Schofield, in each. He also competed on the relay team which was nipped by Fenton by two yards in 1:36.7. Bob Bare, Grand Blanc sophomore, won the shot with a toss of 39 feet.

Bob Perry won the quarter-mile in 55.5, Nate Woodward took the low hurdles in 24.3 and George Crocker copped the mile in 4:57 to pace Fenton.
