

# BATTLE CREEK TRACK WINNER

## Bearcats Crush Sexton and Eastern in Dual Meet Here; Win All Events

Battle Creek high school's track squad took 12 first places in as many events as it routed Sexton and Eastern high schools in a triangular meet Friday afternoon on the Michigan State college track. The Bearcats gathered 84 points, Eastern 18 and Sexton 17. The meet was the second three-way affair in two weeks in which the two local schools were hopelessly outclassed.

The Food City squad so dominated the meet that only four local cindermen reached second place in the competition. Pete Gibson and George Miske of Eastern placed second in the 100-yard dash and broad jump, respectively, while Big Red's Carl Ellis and Dick Hiltz captured the same positions in the half-mile run and pole vault events.

Bearcat Jack Seltenreich accounted for 15 of the team's points by winning the low and high hurdles and shot put.
