

**Track Team Second in 12 School Meet Held in Owosso**

The Howell track team placed second out of 12 schools, by losing the State Journal Invitational meet to Owosso by a score of 52½ to 41 31/40. This meet marked the end of a very successful season for the team having taken all of their dual meets.

Hollis Gehringer was again high point man with 13½ points, taking first in the 100 and 220 yd. dashes and by running the last leg of the 880 yd. relay, which was taken by Howell.

Due to his injured leg, Joe Cook was not able to run in the finals, although he did place in the preliminaries.

Twelve schools participated in the meet and received the following points; Owosso, 52½; Howell, 42 21/40; Fowlerville, 24 3/8; Lansing Eastern, 24 1/5; Charlotte, 24; Mason, 22 1/5; Eaton Rapids, 21 23/40; Lansing Sexton, 15 3/8; Williamston, 11 3/8; Michigan School for the Blind 6; Okemos, 4; Woodland, 3 3/8.

Mosher, Michigan School for the Blind; 52.3; 200 yd. low hurdles—N. Tuick, Owosso—24.2; 220 yd., dash—H. Gehringer, Howell; 22.6; 880 yd. run—B. Boll, Owosso—2:08.5; High jump—J. Clever, Charlotte, 5 ft. 8 in.; Broad jump—R. Dart, Mason; 20 ft. 4 5/8; Shot put—H. Brown, Owosso; 42 ft. ¼ in.; Pole vault—B. Cartwright, Owosso—10 ft. 6 in.; 880 yd. relay—Howell (R. Bain, F. Way, B. Way, H. Gehringer) — 1:38.7.
