Friday, April 30—Triangular Meet at Lansing

Lansing Stxton 18½ Jackson 90 Lansing Eastern 21½

Jackson won its first track meet by defeating Lansing Sexton and Lansing Eastern. Jackson won the meet by taking 10 first places out of 12, and altogether 29 out of the possible 45 places. The Vikings' weak points came out in the 120-yard hurdles and the shot put. Joe Lozier was high scorer in the meet with 14½ points. Dick Johnson was second with 9½ points.

Friday, May 7—Jackson at Kalamazoo

Jackson lost its second track meet, by coming in late, to the Kalamazoo squad. Jackson took firsts in the 100, 220 and 440-yard dashes, the pole vault and the shot put. Jackson, although favored to win the relay, could not keep up the lead given Kalamazoo by Newton. Johnson took both 100 and 220-yard dashes for Jackson.

Friday, May 14—Battle Creek at Jackson

Battle Creek - - - 74 Jackson - - - 30

The Battle Creek Bearcats defeated the Vikings in a dual track meet at Withington Stadium 74 to 30. The Vikings took the following places: Lozier second and Wittliff third in 120-yard dash; W. Pittman second on the mile run, and Jack Dulworth third. Owens took first place in the 440-yard run with a time of 55 and Alger came in

third. Peloske came in third on the 220-yard low hurdles. Third in the 220-yard dash was Biery. Taking first place in the 880-yard run was Moulton with a time of 2:07.6, and Cole came in third. Lozier came in third in the shot put and third in the broad jump. Second in the pole vault was Wetherly and third was Scott.
