ADDING MACHINE DEPT.

Cooley Thinclads Bury All Foes with 161 Points

They didn't have any adding machines at Central High School Friday—but they could have used one.

In the most one-sided triumph in the history of the annual City League indoor meet, Cooley registered 161 points to take the team title. This total not only was 115 points more than the second-place Miller squad scored, but also 12 points more than all the other teams combined.

The balanced Cardinals collected that array of points in spite of failing to capture six individual championships.

Redford's Joe Metz, won the 880, Eastern's Bill Webb the mile, Truman Fisher, also of Eastern, the 440, Cleo Caldwell, of Miller, took the 30 and 220-yard dashes and his teammate, Adam Houghton, won the high jump.

Trailing Cooley and Miller in points were Redford with 31½, Eastern 25, Pershing 15½, Northwestern 8, Central 6, Mackenzie 5½, Cass 5½, Southeastern 4 and Denby and Northern 1 each.

Ted Balogh, Doug Simpson and Bill Marcoux led the Cardinals in piling up their amazing total. Balogh took both the 30-yard hurdles in identical time .04.2. This equals the city record in the high.

Marcoux and Simpson took third and fourth places, respectively, in the lows and ran third and second, respectively, in the highs.

As was expected, the Cardinals picked up 55 points in the short events. They came through with unexpected points in the pole vault when Dick Smith and Jim Harrower tied for first and Al Noble placed fourth.

The most thrilling race of the night's ten-event program was the mile run. Bill Webb, Eastern's bespectacled ace, beat Hal Smith, of Cooley, by six feet.
