

Pioneers Are Runner-Up In Five-A Meet

Battle Creek Is Title Winner In Annual Track Event

Ann Arbor High placed second to Battle Creek in the annual Five-A league track and field meet held Saturday. Battle Creek tallied 57 1/2 points followed by Ann Arbor with 46 1/2, Jackson 42 1/2, Lansing Eastern 31 and Lansing Sexton eight and three-quarters.

Individual winners for Ann Arbor included Don Makielski in the mile, Phil Mercado in the 440 and Bill Haidler in the low hurdles. Haidler also was second in the high jump and second in the broad jump.
