Pioneers Are Runner-Up In Five-A Meet

Battle Creek Is Title Winner In Annual Track Event

Ann Arbor High placed second to Battle Creek in the annual Five-A league track and field meet held Saturday. Battle Creek tallied 57½ points followed by Ann Arbor with 46½, Jackson 42½, Lansing Eastern 31 and Lansing Sexton eight and three-quarters.

Individual winners for Ann Arbor included Don Makielski in the mile, Phil Mercado in the 440 and Bill Haidler in the low hurdles. Haidler also was second in the high jump and second in the broad jump.

Cubs Second In Class C Regional

Weatherill Places In Four Events

University High's track team made a strong showing and placed second to Romulus in the Class C regional track meet held at Ypsilanti Saturday.

Romulus won the meet by amassing a total of 39 3/14 points followed by U High with 33 6/7, Dundee 29 5/14; Roosevelt 23, Milan 16 6/7; Milford 13; Blissford 10 6/7, Warren 4, Morenci 3, Napoleon 3 and Tecumseh 3.

Bob Weatherill of the Cubs placed in four events, tying for first in the high jump, being second in the 220, third in the century and running on the relay team which placed third.

Charley Baker won the 440 for U High and tied for third in the high jump. Don McCreedy was third in the high hurdles with Dude Stephenson fifth. Joe Tobias was third in the lows with Stephenson again fifth. Jim Guthe tied for fourth in the pole vault, Milt Handorf was third in the half mile with Bill Nester fifth.
