

MINSTER 2ND IN VAULT AT STATE MEET

Brown Fourth in Shot Put;
Smith Takes Pair of
Fifth Places

MINSTER LEAPS 11 FEET

Paul Minster, Adrian high school hurdler and pole vaulter, Saturday placed second in the pole vault event in the state Class B track tournament. Minster cleared the bar at 11 feet, but was unable to make 11', 3" in his next three tries. Don Jenkins, Adrian's other trackster entered in the meet, was unable to place in the mile run, although he toured the four laps in 5:01 to take seventh. Points were awarded for only the first six places in each event.

According to Coach Bill Ogden, Jenkins tried to win the race, and in doing so exerted himself in the third lap, which was too much for him.

Other County Men Place

Jack Brown of Tecumseh took fourth in the shot put event in the Class C tournament, and Don Smith, Blissfield speedster, took two fifth places as he placed in both the 100 yard dash and the 220 yard dash.

Saginaw Arthur Hill won the Class A title as Dick Rifenburg, scored 17½ points.

Garion Campbell, Monroe's Negro dash man, was the high scorer in Class A, winning the 200 yard low hurdles, the 120 yard high hurdles, placing second in the broad jump, and fifth in the high jump for a 19 point total. Campbell set a state record in the low hurdles as he scooted the distance in :228.
