Cards Easily Upset Rivals

Harrower Shatters Six-Year-Old Record

John Harrower, Cooley High School pole vaulter, shattered a six-year-old record Saturday afternoon when he soared to 11 feet 10 1/2 inches to furnish the outstanding performance in the Wayne Relays at U. of D. Stadium and lead the Cardinals to a lopsided triumph.

Aside from Harrower's feat, the Cooley thinclads produced the best times in the one-mile medley relay, one-mile relay, two-mile relay and the shuttle hurdles, to pile up 75 1/2 points. Miller gained second place with only 46 points and Denby was third with 28.

Until Harrower made his record vault the mark was held by Ted Webb, of Royal Oak, who cleared the bar at 11 feet 9 inches in 1938.

In the Class B section Trenton noosed out Birmingham, 29 2/3 to 28 5/6, when Bob La Belle, of the Down River school, won the broad jump with a leap of 19 feet 2 1/2 inches.
