

# Pioneer Track Team Defeats Lansing Unit

Eastern Beaten By 26  
Points As Ted Judson  
Wins In Four Events

Coach Tim Ryan's Ann Arbor High track team today holds a 65-39 victory over Lansing Eastern as a result of yesterday afternoon's dual meet here.

Ted Judson, who hasn't been out of double figures this year, hit his highest mark of the season with 20 points garnered by winning both hurdle and both jumping events.

High jump: won by Judson (AA); Palmer (E) and Nixon (E) tied for second. Height—5 feet, 6 inches.

Shot put: won by Falcone (AA); Brown (AA), second; Fredericks (AA), third. Distance—42 feet, 4 inches.
