

As Wolverines Trounce Irish

Ypsi Roosevelt Wins Huron Loop Track Title

YPSILANTI—Ypsilanti Roosevelt High school held the Huron League track championship today after earning 55 points to Romulus' 50 in yesterday afternoon's league meeting at the Michigan State Normal College track.

University High of Ann Arbor, defending champion and winner of the previous three meetings, placed third with 30 1/2 points. Other competing schools were Lincoln Consolidated, 20 points; Milan, 17; Dundee, 7 1/2 and Flat Rock, 0.

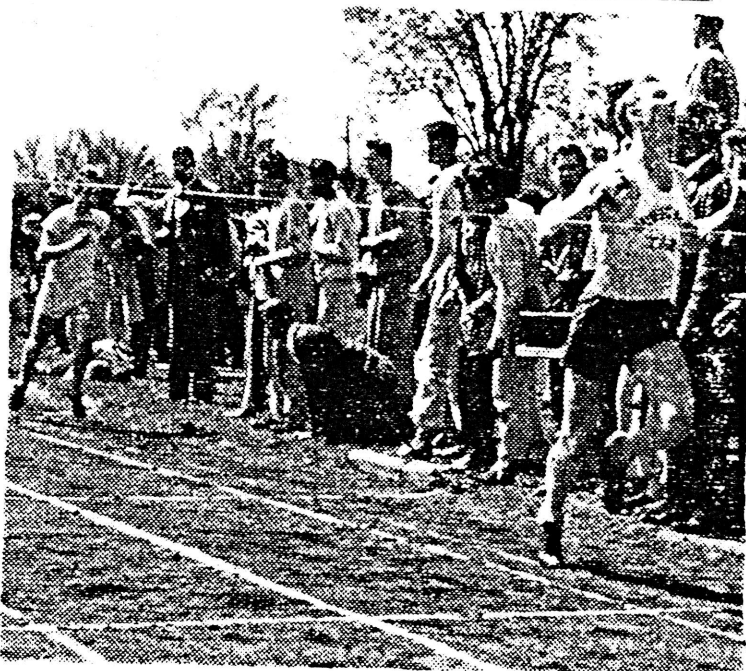
Four records fell in the meet with two Roosevelt entries taking care of a pair of them. Keith Gundrum negotiated the 120-yard high hurdles in 16 seconds flat to crack Teammate Bill Bair's 1944 mark of 16.7 seconds. Bair, not to be outdone, registered a new mark in the low hurdles which he skimmed in 23.3 seconds to erase his own 1944 mark of 24.1 seconds.

Milan's Al Hosler, a great prep school marathoner, shaved 13.8 seconds off the mile run mark as he went the distance in a very creditable 4:25.2. The previous mark was 4:52. Romulus' Luther Butler went five feet nine inches in the high jump to better, by one inch, the record held by U High's Dick Lorch since 1931.

Roosevelt's ace, Bair, was high-point man with 14 points acquired through winning the 100-yard dash and the low hurdle event plus a second-place effort in the broad jump.

The championship effort was the fourth for Coach Art Walker's Rooseveltians, who won in 1930, 1931 and 1932 but had been without a title since.
