Bair, not to be outdone, registered a new mark in the low hurdles which he skimmed in 23.3 seconds to erase his own 1944 mark of 24.1 seconds.

Milan's Al Hosler, a great prenchool marathoner, shaved 13.8 school marathoner. seconds off the mile run mark as he went the distance in a very creditable 4:282.
