

# Local Talent Earns State Track Medals

## Pioneers Third In Top Competition As Judson Stars; Cubs Win Point

Four Ann Arbor schoolboy tracksters could display state meet medals to their schoolmates this morning following placing efforts in Saturday's big track carnival at Michigan State College.

Three of the four carried Ann Arbor High's purple and white colors to a third-place rating in the Class-A meet with Ted Judson starring by tying for first in the high jump, placing third in the low hurdles, second in the high hurdles and fifth in the broad jump.

Ann Arbor High's Makielski twins also counted points for the Pioneers as Ed took the first section of the half-mile run in the good time of 2:02.7 while brother Don placed second in the mile race.

### Judson Is Meet Star

Judson took individual honors with 16½ points to 12 for Flint Central's Owen Jackson. Judson also added two Ann Arbor high records to his laurels in qualifying heats Saturday morning when he won the low hurdles with a time of :15.7 and the highs with a time of :23.4. He also holds the school high jump record.

The Pioneers led the Class-A team title race until the final event but lost out because they had no relay team qualified. Class-A team honors went to Saginaw which earned 29½ points while Flint Central, with 28½, was second. Ann Arbor had 26½ for third place.

Meanwhile U High's Dude Stephenson earned himself a medal in the Class-C meet, which was won by Romulus with 33 points, by placing fourth in the second section of the 440-yard dash.
