2nd by Point
Relay Victory Gives
Trojans Class A Title

EAST LANSING — Saginaw High School's Trojans surged from behind to win the Class A division of the thirty-eighth annual State track championships by a single point. A dramatic victory in the 880-yard relay, the final event on the program, enabled the Saginaw team to edge out Flint Central, 29½ to 28½.

The Saginaw team trailed badly through most of the meet and when the teams lined up for the relay, the Trojans were lagging by three points, following Ann Arbor and Flint Central. Ann Arbor, which failed to qualify a relay team, finished in third place with 26½, Battle Creek was fourth with 23½.

Arthur Hill, of Saginaw, the defending champion and one of the favorites, finished a weak eleventh, with nine points.

OWEN JACKSON and Jesse Thomas, Flint Central's speed twins, accounted for three first places between them, Jackson snaring both dashes and Thomas winning the broad jump. Central may have lost the title in the morning qualifying round when Thomas arrived too late for trials in the high hurdles. His mark of 15.4, set in the regional at Flint last week, was the state's best time.

All Class A records withstood the day's assault. Three standards in Class B and two in Class D were shattered, however.

St. Joseph, the favorite, won the Class B championship with 27 points. East Grand Rapids was second with 22, Cranbrook had 21 and Hastings 20½.

BOMULUS, although shut out in the relay, won the Class C title with 33 points. Lake Shore High, of St. Clair Shores, was second with 21 and Bad Axe was third with 20.

Michigan Deaf outscored the Class D field with 69 7-10 points. Leelanau was second with 51.5 and Bloomfield Hills was third with 49.1-15.

Men of the lower division carried home most of the individual honors. Chief among the record wreckers was Bob Swain.

blond speedster from East Grand Rapids, who broke the 100 and 220-yard dash records for the Class B division.

Swain raced over the century course in .99.9 in the preliminaries, and equaled that mark in winning the final in the afternoon. His mark replaced a 1:12.2 record set by Frenctzak, of Dowagiac, in 1924, and equaled by Mead, of East Lansing, in 1938.

SWAIN CAME back with a 21.8 mark in the 220, bettering Mead's record of 21.8, established in 1938. He also anchored his relay team to victory, for a total of 13 1/2 of his team's 22 points.
