Yanks Swamp Chicago Sox

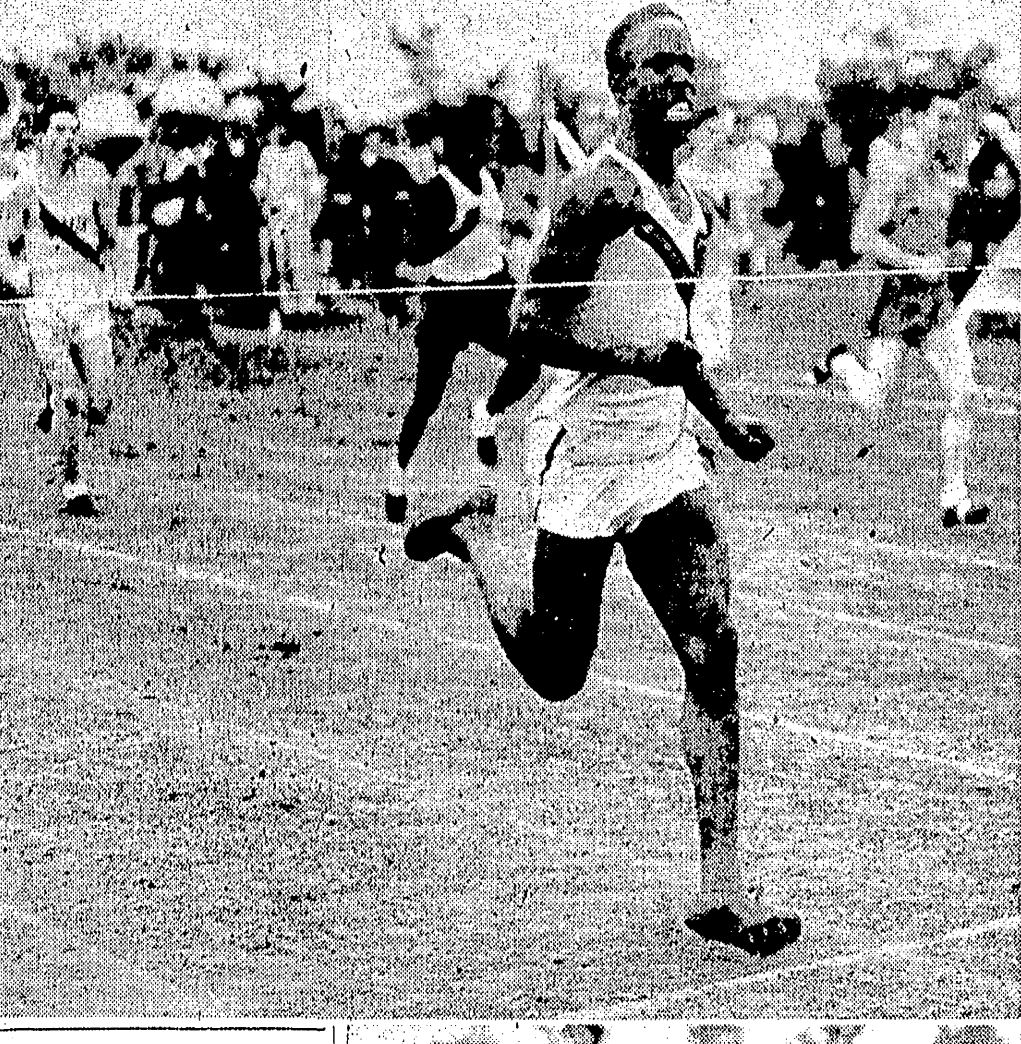
Sweep Four-Game Series With 13-0 Win
