

### Cooley Leads Track Trials

#### Tars Pace East Side After Early Events

Cooley and Denby High Schools took commanding leads in the City League's two sectional indoor track qualifying meets.

At the end of five events in the West League meet at Mackenzie, Cooley had piled up 40 points, while Northwestern had 19, Mackenzie 18, Redford 14, Western 10 and Central 4.

DENBY SCORED 32 7-10 points in five events of the East League meet on the Denby track. Miller was threatening the defending champions with 28 7-10, while the rest of the field trailed far behind. Hamtramck had 10, Southeastern 8, Northern 6, Eastern 6 1-5, Cass Tech 6, Northeastern 5 and Penning 2.

Both meets will be concluded Friday afternoon. Six qualifiers from each event will be entered in the City League semifinals Wednesday afternoon at Central High School.

Don Goodold, Northwestern speed king, took the 30-yard high hurdles and 220-yard dash in the West Side meet, to coast 12 points. Bob Jackson, of Western, scored 10 points, finishing second in the high hurdles and 20-yard dash. Cooley's George Henry won the 30-yard dash and was fourth in the pole vault.

HIGH POINT men in the East side meet were Miller's George Styles and Denby's Tommy Stewart, who tied for first in the pole vault. Styles was second in the high hurdles, while Stewart was runner-up in the 30-yard dash.

Other individual East Side winners were Leon Wingo, of Hamtramck, in the 20-yard dash; Ralph Rowley, of Miller, in the high hurdles; Harry Greenburg, of Southeastern, in the 440-yard dash and Larry Schulte, of Denby, in the mile.

Ross Smith, of Cooley, was the West Side leading miler, and Walter Beede, a teammate, took the pole vault. Beede edged out Al Foley, defending City League champion, and tied Foley's Mackenzie gym record of 11 ft., 9 in.

COOLEY had 11 qualifiers for the semifinals while Northwestern, Redford and Mackenzie had six each. Western had two and Central one. On the East Side Denby and Miller each had eight qualifiers. Eastern and Northern had three each, and Cass Tech, Southeastern, Penning, Northeastern and Hamtramck two each.
