

Second Title for Saginaw

Arthur Hill Second in Class A Track

EAST LANSING, May 25.—(AP)
—Saginaw High School captured the final relay event here today to win the State Class A high school track championship for the second straight year with 36½ points.

Saginaw Arthur Hill finished second with 28 and Muskegon with 24 was third. Two Flint teams—Northern and Central—tied for fourth with 15 points and Jackson grabbed sixth place with 14½.

Saginaw took three first places in the 14 Class A events as Marvin Cichowski won the low hurdles, K. D. McKinnon took the shot and the Trojan relay team nosed out Saginaw Arthur Hill.

Only double winner in Class A was Flint Central's Jesse Thomas, Negro ace, who took the broad jump and high hurdles.

Because of heavy rains that fell all morning and continued half way through the afternoon the crowd of 2,500 fans saw no records broken on Michigan State College's track.

Charlotte won the Class B title with 37 points. East Grand Rapids was crowned winner in Class C, and Mich. School for the Deaf, of Flint repeated in Class D with 52 points.
