Rouge Wins in Class B

Cardinals Amass 73 Points, Set 2 Marks

Breaking two meet records, Cooley High School scored a decisive victory in the twelfth annual Wayne University Relays at Densby Field.

The Cardinals ran up 73 points, as Densby took second place with 52. Other Class A scores were Northwestern 31 1/2, MacArthur 16, 48 1/2, Redford 12, Cass Tech 4 1/2, Miller and Northwestern 20, Riverfront 25, Wyandotte 28, Dearborn 24, Northern 23, Western 22, first Southwestern 21 1/2, Eastern 14, Pershing 13, and Central and Southwestern 8.

RIVER ROUGE won the Class B crown in a close three-way battle. The Panthers scored 59 1/2 points, Ecorse 25 1/2, Birmingham 23 1/2, Wayne 7 1/2, and Trenton, the defending champion, 5 1/2-14.

Cooley's quartet of crack sprinters—Bob Hahn, Don Dickerson, Dave Rice and Ross Smith—broke the four-mile relay record with a time of 19:14. The old record, set by Cooley in 1945, was 19:24.8. Smith, anchor man on the team, was checked unofficially in 4:24 for the final mile.

The other record-breaking performance was by George Henry, Ira Smith, Arnold Conway and Don Harrover in the 440-yard shuttle hurdles relay. They were timed in 5:41 seconds to clip four-fifths of a second off the record set by another Cooley team in 1945.

Howard McCann, 440-foot River Rouge ace, broke the meet's Class B high jump record with a leap of 5 feet 1 1/2 inch. The old record from 1935 of 5 feet 11 inches was set by Ed Culbertson, of Algoma, in 1938.
