Cooley Gains Second Prep Track Victory

The Cooley High School track team took six first places to down Redford, 48½ to 37½, in an indoor dual meet. The victory was the second straight for the defending champions.

Don Harrower led the Cardinals with two firsts, one of which unofficially slashed a 10th of a second off the City League's 30-yard high hurdle mark.

Harrower negotiated the distance in :04.1. His other first was in the low hurdles, where he was also timed in :04.1.

DON LOVE, of Cooley, recorded the season's fastest mile, with Teammate Bob Hahn only a step behind. Love was clocked in 4:43.

Tom Stewart, Denby's one-man track team, took two firsts and tied for another as the Tars ran over Hamtramck, 69½ to 18½. Stewart unofficially clipped half a second off the 220-yard dash mark as he was timed in :24.

He also won the 30-yard dash, tied for first in the pole vault and ran a leg on the Tars' relay team, which toured the half mile in 1:33.8, almost three seconds better than the record.

Western trounced Central, 55 2/5 to 22 3/5.
