

Cooley Rules for 13th Time

East Side Trackmen Are Paced by Denby

Cooley and Denby won as expected in the Metropolitan League's sectional track meets Friday. Cooley captured the West Side crown for the thirteenth time, scoring 67½ points to 35 for Redford, the runner up. Denby took the East Side honors with 56½ points to 37 for Miller.

The events were spread over two days, five in each meet being held Wednesday and five Friday. Cooley, which won three tests Wednesday, took no lists Friday, but piled up enough secondary points to outstrip Redford and Northwestern, the two strongest contenders. Northwestern had 31 points.

GAIN 3 FIRSTS

Denby placed first in three events Friday. Torney Stewart, who won the pole vault and 30-yard dash Wednesday, also took the 30-yard low hurdles and ran on Denby's winning relay team Friday, finishing with 19½ points for individual honors.

Stewart was timed in 3.9 seconds for the hurdles, one-tenth of a second faster than the league record. The Denby relay quartet of Harry Beards, Don Keller, Bruno Boosler and Stewart was caught in 1:03.8 as against the official mark of 1:03.2. The marks are unofficial as records can be set only in the league's semi-finals or finals.

DOUBLE WINNER

Bob Jackson of Western was the only double winner on the West Side, taking the high and low hurdles. Like Stewart, he ran the lows in 3.03.9.

Harry Wilson of Southeastern cleared 6 feet 3 inches in the high jump for the best performance in either league.
