# Cooley Rules for 13th Time

## East Side Trackmen Are Paced by Denby

Cooley and Denby won as expected in the Metropolitan League's sectional track meets Friday. Cooley captured the West Side crown for the thirtieth time, scoring 6 1/2 points to 4 1/2 for Redford, the runner-up. Denby took the East Side honors with 5 1/2 points to 3 1/2 for Motor.

The events were spaced over two days, five in each meet being held Wednesday and five Friday. Cooley, which won three meets Wednesday, took no firsts Friday, but piled up enough secondary points to oust Redford and Northwest from the two strongest contenders. Northwest can build points.

### GAIN 3 FIRSTS

Denby placed first in three events Friday. Tommy Stewart, who won the pole vault and 30-yard dash Wednesday, also took the 30-yard low hurdles and ran off Denby's winning relay team Friday, finishing with 1 1/2 points for individual honors.

Stewart was timed in 3.0 seconds for the hurdles, one tenth of a second faster than the league record. The Denby relay quartet, of Harry Beason, Don Koeler, Bruno Roelster and Stewart, was caught in 1:24 1/2 as against the official mark of 1:32. The marks are unofficial as records can be set only in the league's semi-finals or finals.

### DOUBLE WINNER

Bob Jackson of Western was the only double winner on the West Side, taking the high and low hurdles. Like Stewart, he ran the lows in :03.9.

Harry Wilson of Southeastern cleared 6 feet 3 inches in the high jump for the best performance in either league.
